**DORCAN CHURCH PICNIC** - Sunday 4th July

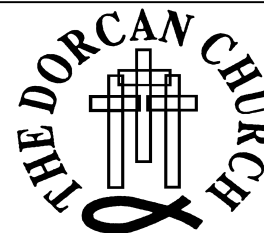
